Topic

Dr. Kinney will discuss the results of the most recent Galveston Bay Report Card and explain how protecting all creeks, rivers, and bayous in the state of Texas is vital to the health of Galveston Bay. Learn about our local water, the Spring Creek and San Jacinto River watersheds, and the actions you can take to protect them.

Speaker

Dr. Kinney is a Research Scientist at HARC, specializing in coastal and wetland ecology. Her research includes wetland restoration, impacts of land use and eutrophication on coastal systems, and carbon and nitrogen cycling in wetlands. She graduated with a PhD in biology from the Boston University Marine Program. Her previous work was as a postdoctoral research associate in the Department of Marine Biology at Texas A&M University Galveston and at the Ecosystem Center at the Marine Biological Laboratory in Woods Hole, MA.
